# CROATIA PRE & POST TOUR IMPORTANT INFORMATION



## AIRPORTS



### Trogir Departures / Arrivals

Most guests fly into Split when their tour begins in Trogir.

- Split Airport (SPU)



### Dubrovnik Departures / Arrivals

Most guests will fly into Dubrovnik when their tour begins here.

- Dubrovnik Airport (DBV)



# TRANSPORTATION

## TROGIR/SPLIT

Taxis/Ubers/private rides are available at the airport to take you to your accommodations. Split Airport is approximately 20 minutes from Trogir.

**DAY OF TOUR:** Ask your driver to take you to the bridge at the Old Town, Trogir Port near the Carmelengo tower.

Split Airport is approximately a ~40 minute drive from Split City. Split City is an approximate ~1 hour drive from Trogir.

## DUBROVNIK

Taxi/Ubers/private rides are available to take you from Dubronik Airport to your accommodations. It is an approximate 35 – 40 minute drive to the city of Drubrovnik.

**Note:** Trogir is a four-hour drive from Dubrovnik.

## TROGIR DEPARTURES:

- The picture of the Pedal & Sea Adventures boat and banner are image examples of what you will find when looking for PSA in Trogir for the South Dalmatia Islands and National Parks tours
- Tell your taxi, Uber driver, or transportation to take you to Camerlengo Castle Tower in Trogir along the promenade – the promenade where the boats will be docked. Guides will be in front of our boat with Pedal & Sea shirts to check you in.
- The tour registration is at 11 AM for all tours.

## WHAT DO OUR BOATS LOOK LIKE? *continued...*

### DUBROVNIK DEPARTURES:

- The port authorities in DUBROVNIK do not permit Pedal & Sea Adventures to have its booth on the promenade. Banners will be on the boat railings (see photo on previous page) and our guides will be in Pedal & Sea shirts.
- In Dubrovnik, the tour starting departure meeting place will be at the port at 11:00 am. There are two possible locations at the port where the boat will be docked.
  - Gruz Market
  - Port of Dubrovnik

The specific boat location is unknown because the port's Harbour Master issues dock sites at the last minute.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION *continued...*

## Registration

- Please be there to register at 11:00 am on the Saturday of your departure. Our staff will tag your luggage, put it in your cabins and confirm when you need to be back on the boat (usually 12:30 pm - 12:45 pm at the latest)
- Guides will confirm boat departure times. Usually 12:45 PM – 1:15 PM depending on the boat and tour.
- Please do not be late. The boats do leave on time – the Captains are given their times by the harbor masters and cannot change these once assigned

## End of Tour

The boats arrive in port Friday evening by 6 PM. Anyone with early Saturday morning travel plans can be accommodated. Guides will make transfer/taxi arrangements on Wednesday on your tour for any guests requiring it.

All tours end Saturday morning with all guests having departed the boat by 8:30 A.M.

## MEDICAL ISSUES AND ALLERGIES

Guests with any medical conditions, medications or allergies that we ought to be aware of, must inform our guides at check-in. **GUESTS WHO CARRY AN EPIPEN:** Please tell the guides at check-in where you keep your EpiPen so they can assist if necessary.

- If you have any cardiac, pulmonary, breathing issues or recent surgeries, we urge you to inform our guides at check-in so we can assist in the best manner possible.
- In the event of an incident, Guides will make the best decisions in consultation with each guest and their respective partners/designates. Guests agree to understand this to be the case.
- **ALLERGIES:** We must be informed of any allergies you have, whether food or substance so we can make every effort to provide a safe environment.
- **DIETARY:** Please confirm any dietary needs at check-in

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

### Boat Information



Each cabin has its own ensuite bathroom, shower, towels and soap, shampoo, etc. All cabins have drawers and cabinets to store your luggage. Most cabins will have hair dryers - you need a European adapter (2 prong).

There are places to hang your wet/washed biking clothes to dry. There are NO guest laundry facilities onboard our boats.

### Luggage



While we hope for no more than 2-carry on size bags, we understand this might not be possible. There is room to accommodate your suitcases whether carry-on or larger, in your cabin.

### Power Adapter



You will require a European 2 prong adapter

### Alcohol



The Bar on the boat is cash only (Euros) - You can run a tab for your cabin that you will need to settle on the final night of your tour.

**OUTSIDE ALCOHOL** - Guests are not permitted to bring their own alcohol on board, per Croatian alcohol regulations. Each boat is stocked with many spirits, beers and wines. Wine may be brought on board - the mandatory corkage fee is 20 Euros per bottle and must be paid to the bartender.

### Dress



Your dress on the boat is very casual. Dress for meals is usually shorts and t-shirts. You may choose to wear more dressier shorts, dresses or slacks to the Captain's Dinner, but it is not necessary. Please avoid high heels while on the boat. Cycling shoes with exposed cleats cannot be worn on the boat.

Cycling gear is widely used and we recommend you have 2 sets; one to wear and one to clean and hang to dry. Rain gear - we are on coastal islands - we could come into a bit of wet weather. Bring your rain jacket.



## Meals

On 3 days, all 3 meals are on the boat. On 4 days, breakfast and either lunch or dinner. Specific days will be identified by guides.

Ask your guides for dining recommendations while on shore.



## Dietary

Any guest with dietary issues or allergies needs to make this known to the guides when checking in. We want/need you to re-engage the issue with guides so they are specifically paying attention to your needs.



# BIKES

Guests may have rented a specific type of bicycle and every effort is made to provide that to you. Our bike mechanics prepare your bikes to be in good working order. Our guides are phenomenal and capable of assisting with many things bike! They will make every effort to keep your bicycle working well. It is your responsibility to treat the bike with reasonable care; eg. Don't drop the bikes, don't drop the batteries, etc. Do not let them fall into the harbour - seriously, it has happened.

Helmets are mandatory to participate in any Pedal & Sea Adventures' cycling tour. We will provide helmets to those who requested when booking. All non-road bikes will have a pannier or trunk bag for you to use.

Water Bottles – A new Pedal & Sea Adventures water bottle is issued to each guest. Unlimited bottled water is available to everyone.

Cycling Safety Decisions – Are squarely the responsibility of our guides – they have the final say (after the Captain re: sailing conditions). Please respect their decision-making to keep you and your fellow guests safe.





## Bike Insurance

In Croatia, bike insurance for minimal costs may be purchased with Euros cash at registration on Day 1. It operates similar to vehicle insurance as you can opt in if desired.

- Weekly Rate:
  - 40 Euros per bike

Many items except negligence are covered; here is what is not covered under insurance:

- E-Bikes:
  - broken batteries from dropping or damaging them while transferring them to chargers.
- All bikes:
  - Unsafe handling, parking of bike around docks, bridges, beaches, etc. causing the bike to fall into any body water.
  - Theft of your bike if it has been left unsupervised.

We rarely have major issues occur, but coverage is inexpensive and likely provides peace of mind for a few Euros per day.

In the event of an accident, damage or no damage; you must obtain the driver's license of any person who is involved. Let your guide know immediately as the police are required to be contacted. This is the law in Croatia. Take a picture of damage if possible.



## Cash



Croatia's official currency is the EURO. It's largely a cash dominated society. You will need to have some cash Euros for certain items in Croatia.

- Bar tab on the boat
- Items purchased while ashore – specific vendors may or may not take credit cards
- Taxis, transfers
- Cycling guide tipping
- Boat crew tipping
- City tour guide tipping
- Meals while on shore



## Tipping

We are frequently asked for guidance on tipping. It is ALWAYS the guests' decision for desired amount or if to tip. Envelops will be provided.

There are two groups to consider tipping:

- Cycling guides
- The entire boat crew

Recommended amount PER GUEST:

- Cycling guides – 70 Euros per guest per guide. For example: 2 guides x 70 Euros = 140 Euros per guest. Adjust accordingly as you see fit.
- Boat crew – We recommend a similar amount. 140 Euros per guest for the boat crew.

## ATMs



There are several ATMs in the port at the beginning of each tour. Those marked with yellow signs will have higher fees. As a rule, choose the conversion amount applied by your own bank. They will be lower.

# CHECKLIST

## Items We Suggest You Bring

- Airline tickets
- Valid Passport or government ID
- Phone and charger
- Luggage: 2 carry-on sized suitcases, if possible, but not necessary.
- One personal bag: if your tour has a hiking portion, a knapsack to carry items
- Cycling jersey (short sleeve and long sleeve) (2-3)
- Cycling shorts: 1 - 3 pairs
- Arm warmers
- Cycling rain gear (jacket, pants waterproof and breathable)
- Cycling shoes, only if clipping in.
- Cycling gloves
- Helmet: if you wish to bring your own, otherwise one will be provided at no additional cost
- Comfortable walking shoes sweater, light jacket or windbreaker for after dinner
- Bring a few lightweight, easily washable items for city wear (dinner and sightseeing)
- Fleece / Lycra sweater / long sleeves
- Sun hat or visor
- Sandals for beach or kayak
- Swimsuit
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen/bug spray
- Any medical or nutritional items you deem necessary
- Gel seat cover, or your own saddle (do not bring the post).
- Universal power outlet adapter, or European power outlet adapter
- Rear view mirror, if desired.
- Pedals: If you want to clip in, bring your own pedals. Our guides will put them on your bike. This does not apply to e-bikes.
- Extra water bottle, if needed.
- Chamois cream
